## SENIORS

05/04/12-MR. C'S PHOTOGRAPHY COWLITZ COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP-Must be a graduating senior from Cowlitz County planning on attending an accredited two or four year university. A letter outlining your future goals, two letters of recommendation, and transcripts are required. Sign up on the window next to Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/04/12-COWLITZ VALLEY RUNNERS SCHOLARSHIP-Three \$500 scholarships will be awarded to local high school runners. Applicants must have participated in track or cross-country on a high school team for at least three years. Must provide high

school transcripts and one current letter of recommendation from a running coach. Sign up on the window outside Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/07/12-CAROLINE HOWELL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP-(TLHS) Same application as for the TLEA scholarship. TLEA will choose one winner and a second winner will get the Caroline Howell Memorial Scholarship. Sign up on the window next to Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/07/12-CAROL FOX MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP-(TLHS) An applicant's financial need shall be the primary consideration for receiving this scholarship. Also considered will be the application with essays, high school transcript, and three letters of recommendation. Sign up on the window next to Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/07/12-GARY FINKAS SCHOLARSHIP-Applicants must have a 2.75 GPA or higher and be an active member in good standing in one or more of the following: FBLA, FFA, Key Club, Ecology Club, 4-H, or Student Council (class or ASB officer). Applicants must also be pursuing a degree in one of the following programs of study: K-12 Education/Teaching, Natural Resources, Fish & Wildlife, Agricultural/Environmental Sciences, or Business/Business Management. Sign up on the window next to Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/09/12-LONGVIEW EARLY EDITION ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP-(local) One scholarship awarded based on academic record, extracurricular activities, community service, financial need and quality of scholarship application. Scholarship must be used at Lower Columbia College. Sign up on the window near Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/10/12-BILL DAVIS MEMORIAL-This is a business related scholarship. Applicants should have taken business courses in high school or have been involved in business related extracurricular activities. Sign up on the window near Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/10/12-LONGVIEW NOON ROTARY-Must be a student who has demonstrated good citizenship and a desire to complete a college or vocational education. Consideration will be given to GPA, participation in school and community activities and financial need. We must screen applications first as we can only turn in three total from our school. Sign up on the window near Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive more information.

05/14/12-KEITH "DUDE" WILBANKS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP-(TLHS) \$400 Scholarship must be used at a technical/vocational school or community college. Minimum GPA of 2.0 to apply. Must be used within one year of the award. Sign up on Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/15/12-TOUTLE VALLEY VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS AND AUXILIARY SCHOLARSHIP (local)-Based on community service, extracurricular activities, accomplishments, personal goals, and financial need. Sign up on the window next to Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/16/2012-LOWER COLUMBIA CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARHIP-Must be an Association member, employee of an Association member, or a child or grandchild of an Association member or employees to apply. Applications will be judged

according to the following: academic record, work experience, community service/school activities/extra curricular activities and awards, letters of recommendation, financial need, and presentation of application and essay. Sign up on the window next to Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/18/12-PAT SAWYER MEMORIAL GRANT-IN AID-(Cowlitz County) Applicant must live in Cowlitz County and be a female majoring in education. Awarded on the basis of financial need, academic performance, school activities, and service. Sign up on the window next to Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/18/12-CLOCK OPERATOR'S SCHOLARSHIP (local)- One student/athlete will be chosen to receive a \$300 scholarship from each of the following sports: boys' basketball and girls' basketball. Athletes must have a minimum 2.0 GPA, have a good attitude and be a hard worker. Applicants must write a letter of application to Toutle Lake's Athletic Director to apply. Scholarship must be used at a technical/vocational school, community college or four year college. Scholarship must also be used within one year of the award. Letter due to Eric Swanson by May 18, 2012. Sign up on the window next to Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive information on how to apply.

05/18/12- CASTLE ROCK LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP-(local) One \$1500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior of Toutle Lake High School this year. Based on financial need, GPA, a sense of responsible citizenship, conduct must be acceptable in school and throughout the community, leadership qualities, and a sense of direction toward a career choice. Sign up on the window next to Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/18/12-- SHANE AARON SMITH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP-(local) Priority consideration will be given to students who demonstrate a commitment to our community and in particular a dedication to enrich the lives of those less fortunate than themselves. An essay is required with the application. Sign up on the window near Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive an application.

05/23/12-CASTLE ROCK/TOUTLE LAKE BASEBALL SCHOLARSHIP-Three letters of recommendation, a personal essay of approximately 750 words, and your high school transcript must be included with the application. To qualify for this scholarship, applicants need to have played at least one complete baseball season in the Castle Rock/Toutle Lake Baseball League. Sign up on the window next to Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive the application.

05/30/12-BUS DRIVER'S SCHOLARSHIP-Based on application and an essay telling about your future goals and why you should receive the scholarship. Also included should be what college you will be attending, what you plan to study, and why. Sign up on the window next to Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive more information.

05/31/12-RUBY ZUEGER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP-Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Based on involvement in school and community service activities. Sign up on the window next to Mrs. Frandsen's door to receive more information.

06/01/12-ENOLOGY AND VITICULTURE SCHOLARSHIP-Scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$3000 available to college bound students planning to study viticulture and/or enology.

06/30/12-COLLEGE BOUND SCHOLARSHIP-Students currently in grades 7 and 8 are eligible to apply if they are eligible for free or reduced lunches, their family is receiving TANF benefits, they are a foster youth, or their family meets the income standards. This is a full tuition scholarship for students who graduate with at least a 2.0 GPA, continue to be a good citizen and do not commit a felony, submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in your senior year of high school, and meet the income standards.
